Since three years I have been a member of the Interschool Astronomical Club in Grudziadz. The classes allow me to participate in interesting programs such as Comenius project "In Orbit with Europe", in which the planetarium is involved. With the school club I can do remote observations using telescopes around the world (Faulkes Telescope North, Faulkes Telescope South, NOS -1, NOS -2), observe using a reflector and refractor telescopes in the observatory located in my town and learn how to use planetarium equipment. Annual production of the paper on the National Youth Astronomical Seminar allows me to explore in more detail about selected areas of astronomy and objects in space. In addition, by gaining achievements in the National Youth Astronomical Seminar I have access to free astronomical press. As a member of the National Children's Fund, I took part in astronomical workshops in Piwnice and astronomical workshops during the research camp in Serock. During these workshops I participated in a number of interesting lectures and activities prepared by professional astronomers. I attend and help to organize a number of events organized by our Planetarium and Observatory (including the transit of Venus, Perseids 2013, the hunt for planets) and twice helped the organization of shows near a radio telescope located in the Centre for Astronomy of the UMK at the Festival of Science and Arts (2012, 2013). I have participated in the search for the asteroids IASC and Pan-STARRS. Through this program, I was co-discoverer of asteroid 2013 EY77. I am also a member of the Polish Association of Amateur Astronomers.
